



2019 EMO California State Championship October 5-6, 2019 Paso Robles Event Center

Championship FAQ's:

What is the EMO California State Championship? A championship style event for PCQHA Amateur exhibitors held in conjunction with the Fall Classic Quarter Horse Show

What are the qualifications? Qualifiers are selected from a set of core classes from the year-end PCQHA points (Example: For the 2019 EMO California State Championship, the top 35 exhibitors are chosen from the 2018 year-end standings.) Or you can qualify by showing to 5 AQHA judges at PCQHA approved shows.

Where is the event being held? The 2019 EMO California State Championship will be held in conjunction with the Fall Class AQHA Show in Paso Robles.

What days do I show? All Championship classes will be held on the weekend (October 5th & 6th) during the Amateur portion of the Fall Classic Quarter Horse Show.

The Fall Classic is 4 days so how will the EMO championship classes be scheduled? EMO Championship classes will run as a "class within a class" during the designated AQHA class. Refer to the Fall Classic schedule and class list to learn which day your EMO championship classes will be held.

Which core classes are included?

- Showmanship, Western Pleasure, Western Horsemanship, Hunter Under Saddle, Hunt Seat Equitation, Trail and Ranch Riding

Which divisions are offered?

- Amateur Level 1 (Novice), Amateur and Amateur Select

What are the prizes for the Champions? Beautiful Silverado Silver Buckles will be given to the Champion in each class along with a Champion's Ribbon and prize money!

How do I enter? An invitation will be mailed around August 1st.

What is the fee for each class? The entry fee is \$50 per class. CQHA will add \$25 from each entry to the jackpot purse. Guaranteed \$5,000+ payout.



What happens if I have a different horse? Qualifying is by horse and rider combination from 2018, therefore substitutions cannot be accepted.

Refunds: No refunds will be given after the entry deadline unless a vet certificate is presented to the show manager or emailed to pcqhaoffice@gmail.com at least 24 hrs before the start of the show.
