

FALL CLASSIC

General Rules

APPROVALS – Classes offered at the Fall Classic Horse Show are approved by the AQHA, PCQHA and NSBA. All classes will be conducted in accordance with AQHA rules. All futurities will be governed by NSBA rules. It is the obligation of the exhibitor to be familiar with and abide by these rules. If you have any questions consult the AQHA/NSBA rule books, download the associations', free apps or ask show management

NSBA DUAL APPROVAL – Exhibitors showing in NSBA dual approved classes must enter the corresponding AQHA class. However, exhibitors in AQHA classes are not required to enter in the corresponding NSBA class. You may show in both AQHA & NSBA on one day and only AQHA on the second day if you choose.

11&U Walk/Trot – All Breeds may show. Breed registration and/or exhibitor membership not required to show and receive awards. Hoof black, banded manes and silver allowed in Ranch Riding

PROCEDURE CHANGES – CQHA Show Management bears no responsibility for typographical errors in the show premium. Management reserves the right to change, combine, add to, or cancel awards and adjust arenas and/or class schedules as it deems necessary for the good of all exhibitors

REFUND REQUESTS must be made in writing. Request made prior to close of entries will receive a full refund. After 9/25 a veterinarian's certificate on his/her official letterhead must be submitted stating veterinarian's diagnosis. All withdrawals will be subject to a \$25 office fee. After the start of the show requests for refunds can be submitted to CQHA Board of Directors for consideration. No stall fee refunds after 9/25. Entries not withdrawn within 24 hours of start of show will be subject to all charges.

CREDIT CARDS & NSF – 4% convenience fee for credit card payments. Checks returned for insufficient funds or credit cards that are declined will be charged \$40.

PARKING – All parking of vehicles and trailers must be in designated areas. No parking between barns. All lanes must be kept open for fairgrounds and emergency personal/equipment. Violators will be towed at owner's expense.

VALID DRIVERS LICENSE is required of anyone operating any type of motorized vehicle. Proof of insurance maybe requested by show grounds management. All scooters, bikes, golf carts etc must be kept clear of any horse activity around the barns and all arenas. NO skateboards or razors are allowed on the show grounds

Exhibitors/owners/guests are expected to behave in an orderly manner. Horses and other animals must always be treated with dignity and respect. Management has the right to remove those who do not do so. Any person who is asked to leave for unsportsmanlike conduct and/or for the inhumane treatment of animals will be reported to AQHA and/or proper authorities.
